## Analysis of a Design Process:

  - Conduct interviews with the architect(s) involved to gain insights into the legal processes followed.
- 2. Management Actions and Facts:
  - o Investigate the management actions and facts associated with the project.
  - Examine how project management was executed, including aspects like scheduling, budgeting, and resource allocation.
- 3. Design Process Details:
  - Provide a detailed account of the design process, highlighting key milestones and decisions.
  - Report any challenges or problems encountered during the design phase and how they were addressed.
- 4. Visual Aids and Citations:
  - Utilize drawings, graphics, photographs, pictures, and tables to illustrate key points.
  - Ensure proper citation of sources and references for all content used.

All content should be compiled and submitted digitally via A1 posters in portrait format. The exact submission date will be announced later, likely during the final exam week/s.

This assignment will provide students with a practical understanding of the complexities involved in architectural design and construction, as well as the legal and managerial aspects of such projects.
